Welcome

White Horse Cottage is located in the picturesque village of Wellow, Nottinghamshire, set around "The Green" and its famous maypole. The nearest village is Ollerton (2 miles) and Newark (13 miles).

The cottage dates back to the 17th century and welcomes you with a wealth of character with beamed ceilings, open fireplaces and years of history.

The cottage provides excellent fully equipped self-catering accommodation with all modern comforts and includes 3 bedrooms (sleeping 6), family bathroom, two sitting rooms with one containing an exposed brick fireplace and log burner, kitchen/diner and a downstairs shower room with small sauna. Free wi-fi is available.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to White Horse Cottage by bus and train.
- Bus from Nottingham City Centre to Ollerton (65 minutes) The bus stop is 2.00 miles / 105.0 km from White Horse Cottage.
- The nearest train station is Nottingham City Centre Railway Station. The train station is 22 miles / 35.4 km from White Horse Cottage.

- You can get a taxi with Acorn Travel by calling 01623 861685.

Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point does not have a dropped kerb.
- From the parking to the main entrance, there are 25 steps. There is no ramp and no lift.

Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there are 50 steps. There is no ramp and no lift.

Main entrance

- The door is 864mm wide.
- The main entrance has 0 steps.
- The other entrance door is 864.00mm wide.

- Front of the cottage
- Key is accessed via a key box on the wall at the back of the property.
The code to retrieve the key is given to guest when their balance payment has been received.

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights and bedside lamps.
- Lights are traditional filament. Some lights can be controlled independently.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.

- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- We have wi-fi free bedrooms, for visitors with electro-sensitivity.
- We can move the bedroom furniture, to improve accessibility.
- No bedrooms have level access. The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 10 steps.
- We have bathrooms with a separate shower.
- We have bathrooms with a bath.

- We have an open plan kitchen.
- The work surface is available at a height between 650mm and 900mm.
- The hob is available at a height between 650mm and 900mm.
- The sink is available at a height between 650mm and 900mm.
- The oven is available at a height between 650mm and 900mm.

Lounge

Lounge 1

- From the main entrance to the lounge, there are 5 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.

- Access to the lounge is via the hallway which has a terracotta tiled floor and a wooden door.
There is one step up into Lounge 1 from the hallway.

- From the main entrance to this area, there are 5 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.

- From the main entrance to the gardens, there are 10 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
